Subject areas covered in Autumn 1			
Maths - Place Value / Addition & Subtraction	We are looking at the value of a digit. We will be able to talk about if a number is bigger or smaller than another. We will be using part whole models and begin to form and complete number sentences.		
English - Character description	We are looking at describing using adjectives. We know adjectives can describe the size, shape, colour, texture and the characteristic of an object.		
Spellings - The Alphabet	We are looking at lower and upper case letters and how they can differ in their formation. We are improving our understanding of the order of the alphabet.		
Grammar - Words and sentence	We are looking at how letters form words and words form sentences. We are making sentences of our own and reading them to check they make sense.		
Handwriting - Ladder letters	We are taking our time to work on our letter formation of l, i, t and u.		
Reading - Canine Helpers	We are exploring the canine helpers and how they can help us to explore a book.		
Science - Becoming Scientists	We are exploring colours and shadow through various science experiments.		
RE - Christianity	We are exploring the Christian Creation story.		
Topic - The Great Fire of London	We are learning about how the fire started, why it spread and how it was put out. We are thinking about how the fire changed London and how the development of houses has changed over time.		
PSHE	We have been learning about different emotions and how they change our body language.		
Computing	We have been learning about computer coding. We have been following instructions and learning about the importance of them being in order.		
PE (Tuesday/Thursday)	We have been playing lots of games to develop our team work skills and also learning about different ways to move.		
Homework activity	Additional detail	Expectation	Rewards
Reading 	Record in your reading diary when you have read. Try and read 3-5 times per week. Please try to read to an adult with your school reading book . Adults - please use the Canine questions that will be in the home / school diary. We are focusing on a canine each week to check your child's understanding about what they have read. It is important that children read for pleasure but also that they understand what they are reading. You may find it useful to access: https://www.littlewandlelettersandsounds.org.uk/resources/for-parents/ This will share example videos of how we pronounce the phase 2 and 3 sounds.	5-10 minutes per session	House points and reading challenge rewards.
Grammar and Spelling 	Look at the Common Exception words stuck in your child's home/school diary. We would like your children to work on these at home. These will be re-tested each term. Check your home / school diary to see if there are any words listed in there from the Reading Practice sessions. If children want to write these in sentences, we would love to see this!	5 minutes per session	House points given Spelling bee challenge
