

This time of year is always brimming with activity and the last two weeks have been no exception! Let's have a quick look at what we have been up to:


- We welcomed our new Reception intake to school.

Talk About Online Safety

Have regular conversations with your child about what they do online. Ask them about their favourite apps, games, and websites. Encourage them to speak up if something makes them feel uncomfortable.

Use Parental Controls

Set up parental controls on devices and home Wi-Fi to help filter inappropriate content and manage screen time. The UK Safer Internet Centre offers excellent guides for setting these up.

Keep Devices in Shared Spaces

Encourage children to use tablets, phones, and computers in family areas rather than bedrooms. This helps you stay involved in their online activity.

S – Stay Safe

M – Don't Meet Up

A – Accepting Files Can Be Dangerous

R – Reliable? Check Information

T – Tell Someone
